

## Modern Slavery Policy Statement

It is the policy of Aqwise-Wise Water Technologies Ltd., not to utilise the services of suppliers and sub-contractors who have links to Modern Slavery, Child Labour and Human Trafficking.

Aqwise provides design, engineering and BOT services across the globe, for both the municipal and industrial markets. The potential for modern slavery within the supply chain has been assessed as low risk from our first tier, client framework suppliers and sub-contractors having links to modern slavery, child labour or human trafficking.

Due to the nature of work conducted and items supplied by Aqwise, the risk of engaging the services of a supplier or sub-contractor with links to modern slavery is considered as low. Nevertheless, when engaging all new and existing suppliers or sub-contractors regardless of geography, framework or services provided, Aqwise will make sure no modern slavery, child labour or human trafficking takes place.

To ensure compliance with the Modern Slavery Act 2015, Aqwise will continue to:

- Use due diligence when utilizing the services of suppliers and sub-contractors who operate in locations or areas considered high risk where modern slavery, human trafficking or child labour is more prevalent
- Review existing suppliers and sub-contractors and request an annual declaration of compliance with the Modern Slavery Act 2015
- Introduced a clause in supplier and sub-contractor terms and conditions relating to action taken in the event of non-compliance with the modern slavery act
- Conduct audits on suppliers or sub-contractors where it is suspected that modern slavery, human trafficking or child labour may be used
- Communicate this policy to all employees and make this policy readily available on the company's website
- Provide employees with training to increase their awareness of modern slavery, child labour and human trafficking and to ensure regular refresher training is conducted.

Where suppliers or sub-contractors are found to have links to modern slavery, human trafficking or child labour, then Aqwise will terminate the services of that supplier or sub-contractor and report it to the authorities.

Anyone who suspects there may be Modern Slavery, Child Labour or Human Trafficking are to report their suspicions to their direct line manager, or by calling the police.

The Management and Board of Directors will review and approve this policy at the end of each financial year and revise or update it as necessary.
